Background

FEMA's National Urban Search and Rescue (US&R) Response System (the System) reorganized the advisory structure into a new Advisory Organization found in the National US&R Response System Administrative Manual Annex A. The working groups were redesigned into four Functional Groups. Under these Functional Groups will be sub groups dealing with specific areas. The Logistical Functions Group has been comprised of three sub groups: Equipment (9 members), Transportation (5 members) can Communications (9 members). These Members are considered "subject matter experts" in the field of FEMA US&R Logistics.

The Communications Sub Group member takes an active role in the FEMA US&R communications program. A member will expect to be tasked with any number of assignments which could include but not limited to: researching new technology, developing training programs, maintenance of the communications cache list, representing assigned taskforces, etc. As a member, written documents, intergroup communication, and taskforce outreach will be required for tasks and assignments.

Knowledge

- Be rostered as a primary position of communications specialist on any of the 28 taskforces.
 - Have deployed a minimum of three (3) times on an actual incidents in the position of communications specialist is highly desired
- Above competent working knowledge of all US&R Communications equipment
- General understanding of a US&R Incident Support Team (IST)
- General understanding of an Incident Management Team (IMT)
- Working knowledge of the NIMS framework
- Familiarity with the Training Program and Administration Manual (TPAM)
- General understanding of Mobile Emergency Communications Support (MERS)
- Additional knowledge that is preferred, but not required:
 - o Deployed five (5) or more times on incidents in the position of communications specialist
 - o Experience in public safety communications
 - o Experience in I.T. related to public safety
 - o Experience in Military/DOD/DHS communications
 - o Experience in positions with IMTs/IST
